FAQs

Q: WHERE SHOULD WE PARK?

A: The easiest place to park is in the gravel lot or along the side streets. All of the festivities will take place on the playground.

Q: I'M ENTERING THE CROCKPOT COOKOFF, WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

A: You can drop your entry off in a crock pot at 5:45. It can be any kind of meal that is made and served in a crockpot! Please include serving utensils and label all of your items with your name. Please pick up your crock pot and serving items before you leave! Awards will be tallied and announced on Monday.

Q: HOW DOES THE CROCKPOT COOKOFF WORK?

A: For \$5.00 you will get 5 tickets, a tasting bowl, and a voting ballot. You will trade a ticket for a small portion of the meal you'd like to try. Each meal will be marked with a number so you can decide which you liked best. You're welcome to purchase as many as you'd like.

Q: SHOULD STUDENTS WEAR COSTUMES?

A: No thank you. This is a Harvest Festival, not a Halloween Party.

Q: DO STUDENTS NEED TO WEAR THEIR UNIFORMS?
